

Project Update St Annes Event Space

The ambitious regeneration project aims to create an attractive event space and enhance public area's in the heart of St Annes. Increasing events in the town centre will lead to more footfall from visitors and residents with the long term goal of generating economic activity. The event space is part of the St Annes Masterplan, which has been designed to improve the look and feel of the town centre, promote public transport and enhance the character of the conservation area.

January Milestones: Progress Made

Construction has made excellent progress thus far, with the first phase of improvements advancing ahead of schedule. The main works commenced on 6 January:

- Relocated bus stops outside of Boots
- Reclaimed flags have been put down where the temp finish was at the northern lay-by
- Middle dome was removed and reused at Fairhaven Lake subject to planning

February Focus: Upcoming Work

- Preparations of foundations in event space area
- Laying new drainage and underground services
- One way traffic to continue
- Westbound bus stop temporarily relocated to The Cresent whilst southern bus lay-by. Dates and times TBC
- Feb 18th car park outside NatWest is being temp closed until May then will function as before.
