The ambitious regeneration project aims to create an attractive event space and enhance public area's in the heart of St Annes. Increasing events in the town centre will lead to more footfall from visitors and residents with the long term goal of generating economic activity. The event space is part of the St Annes Masterplan, which has been designed to improve the look and feel of the town centre, promote public transport and enhance the character of the conservation area.

February Milestones: Progress Made

- A section of the St Annes Square Car Park (outside NatWest) has been temporarily closed until May to allow for the delivery of works.
- Site clearance on the car park has commenced with the removal of planters.
- Site clearance and excavation have continued on the North Side.
- Drainage works have commenced.



March Focus: Upcoming Work

In the coming weeks, the South Side Bus Stop will be temporarily closed and moved to a new location at the Crescent. The closure comes as part of our efforts to improve public transport provisions and traffic efficiency in St Annes by providing a new bus lay-by in the area. In addition to the temporary bus stop at the Crescent, passengers are encouraged to continue to utilise the bus shelters near the Lord Derby and M&S for services towards Blackpool & Lytham.

- North Side completion of drainage and highway gullies.
- Installation of kerbs and foundations for paving and feature benches.
- South Side to excavate old car park and install foundations for new paving areas. Removing old kerbs and install new highway drainage.
- One way traffic to continue.
