

Project Update

Talbot Road/Seymour Road

Works have now started on the latest phase of Trafford Council's programme of constructing cyclops junctions along the A56 Chester Road and Talbot Road. The junction improvements will see the creation of a safe continuous cycling and walking link through to the centre of Trafford, opening the area up for active travel, improving safety and taking cars off the road.

This phase will see the junctions of Talbot Rd/Chester Rd and Talbot Rd/Seymour Rd undergoing major reconfiguration into cycle friendly links and cyclops junctions, including smart signals to cut down on unnecessary waiting. Talbot Road is a very busy road and well used by local cyclists, these works will make it easier and safer to use and hopefully make active travel more appealing to less confident members of the community.

Works are programmed to be completed by Christmas 2025.

Progress

July 2025

Work has continued at Chester Rd junction, with the drainage completed and installation of new ducts for the proposed traffic lights around 75% complete. The construction of the new islands is also around 75% complete.

Work has also continued on Seymour Grove with the reconstruction of the footway outside the Metro Station and a new cycleway island that extends into Talbot Road.

August 2025

We intend to reconstruct the footway outside the hotel on Talbot Road (delayed due to HV cables in the way) and once this is complete we can close the section of road (during nights) between White City Way and Seymour Grove for the first phase of road resurfacing.

The footway outside the Metro Station is due to be completed (apart from the final surfacing) in time for the Man Utd vs Fiorentina on Sat 9th August.

We should also complete the new islands in Chester Road junction by late August, when work will move to the northern footway.
