

Project Update

St Helens Active Travel Scheme

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The St Helens Road Active Travel Scheme aims to create a safe and efficient cycling corridor along the western side of St Helens Road. The works feature a new bi-directional segregated cycle route which will require alterations to the existing street layout, incorporating environmental improvements to pavements and footway surfaces. The works include improvement of footway facilities with toucan crossings to be implemented at existing crossing points by Bonnywell Road and West Bridgewater Street. Works started on Monday 30th September, with the aim for completion by Easter 2025.

Work Carried Out In June

All major footway and cycleway work, including the surfacing, were completed in June, including the new bus stop near the car wash (although the installation of the new shelter is a couple of weeks away).

The road resurfacing to the main road, including the road markings, were completed over 3 consecutive Sundays, although some of the side road junctions were completed during the week.

Work Planned For July

July should see the completion of the scheme, with the footway works to access the canal, the removal of the compounds (including making good) and the construction of a link footway to the linear park.

A temporary bus stop has been installed while we await the installation of the new bus shelter, which is expected in early August.
